EGAST was founded in the early 1980s as a family-owned business, with a focus on agriculture, particularly the development and reclamation of desert land. Over the years, we have become a leading producer of high-quality potatoes and fresh produce. In 2005, we expanded our reach by entering the export market, and today, we are one of the largest exporters in the fresh produce industry.

All of our potatoes are exclusively grown in the PFA (Pest Free Area) and are certified to meet Global GAP standards, reflecting our commitment to quality and sustainability. We also operate our own citrus plantation, ensuring that we can consistently deliver high-quality products from field to fork.

Supported by a dedicated team and state-of-the-art infrastructure, Egast generates an annual turnover exceeding \$75 million USD and continues to experience steady growth.

The state of the art pack-house, being BRC certified, enjoys a strictly controlled system whereby production flow is set to cater for the customer needs and requirements. OUR PACKING HOUSE

We operate four packing houses for potatoes, with a daily production averaging 1500 tons.

Our packing methods utilize wooden boxes and advanced packing and storage equipment to ensure the gentle handling of our potato products.

Citrus Packing houses:

We have two dedicated packing lines for citrus, equipped with the latest technology, including Global scan G7, with a combined production capacity of 600 tons per day.



OUR COLD STORES

Egast has expanded its cold storage capacity to about 70,000 tons by adopting modern storage methods, by using wooden boxes for potatoes and a shuttle racking system for citrus, along with advanced techniques including PC control for maintaining the ideal cooling environment.

Our commitment to delivering exceptional products is evident in our high build quality, flawless operations, and gentle yet effective crop handling, minimizing damage during storage.

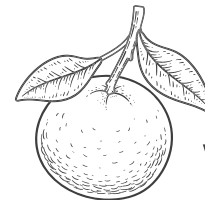
